OLD COMEDY HALL: The Parowan Dramatic Association was organized in 1851 with Edward Dalton President, Jessie V. Smith, Joseph, Jane and Annie Fish, David and Wm. Cluff, Wm. C. McGregor, and Ed Ward members. Plays were produced in the Log Council House and Rock Chuch until in 1870, when the Comedy Hall was erected. In 1897 the Parowan Dramatic Association built a brick Opera House on the site of Comedy Hall. Plays wer egiven in Old Building while the new walls were built around it. Some of the outstanding plays of the day were presented.
