The First wagon over the old Spanish Trail came into Iron County, Utah, May 15, 1848, with the 25 Mormon Battalion men returning from California under Captain Henry G. Boyle. Piloted by Porter Rockwell & James Shaw, they converted the western half of the old pack trail was thereafter known as the Southern California Emigrant Route.
