

AUGUST MEETING OF

COUNTY COMMISSIONERS

The board of County Commissioners of Iron County met in regular session August 10, 1924. There were present: H. L. Adams, chairman; Myron D. Higbee, Geo. B. Williams, John W. Bentley, Clerk; Clair Rowley, Treasurer; J. T. Leigh, Sheriff; R. J. Shay, Deputy County Attorney; D. Claude Urie, Road Supervisor.

Minutes of the July meeting were read and approved and business transacted as follows:

Messrs. Ras. Anderson, Thomas Thorley and Wm. Adams met again with the Board to discuss the Cedar-Kanarra Mountain and Miners Peak road with the commissioners. After a very lengthy discussion upon the matter, it was moved by Commissioner Geo. Berry Williams and seconded by Myron D. Higbee, that the road supervisor be instructed to repair the Cedar-Kanarra Mountain Road to the Washington County line, also the Miners Peak road from the Old Co-op pasture to Miners Peak, also that the owners of said ranches be asked to pay 50-50 for said work.

Mr. D. Claude Urie and Assessor Dalley reported their findings on the Terry ranch road, and recommended an appropriation of \$150.00 to cover part of the cost of building that road. An appropriation of \$150.00 was made for the above named road same to be expended under the supervision of the county road supervisor.

The road supervisor reported the road built by Mr. Don Urie and California and Utah Investment company in good condition and recommended the same, be accepted. It was moved that the road built by Mr. Urie and California and Utah Investment company be accepted passed. It was further moved that Iron County furnish the cement for a submerged spillway in the crossing near the Webster farm. The Clerk was instructed to write the Webster Bros. of the action of the board and that the work in said crossing is to be under the supervision of the road supervisor.

The matter of a probation officer for Iron County was taken up by the commissioners, and upon the recommendation of the deputy county attorney, Mr. William W. Butler was named by the commissioners as Probation Juvenile Officer for Iron County, and recommended his appointment by the proper officials in charge. The clerk was instructed to write the officials for his appointment at a very early date.

An ordinance fixing the boundary lines of the voting precincts of Iron County recently redistricted was approved by the commissioners subject to the approval and checking of the county assessor.

Commissioner Adams was appointed to ask the City Council of Parowan City to co-operate with the county in appointing some one to take charge of the weights and measures and inspection of fruits, etc. Upon recommendation of Alma Esplin, County Agent, it was moved and duly seconded that we write the State for State aid in eradicating the poison milk weed, which is spreading rapidly in Southern Utah. He also reported that dead animals are being found in and near the beds of milk weed, it being as reported by his Deputy John H. Williams.

The matter of a steel counter and fixtures to County Treasurer's office was discussed at some length, it was finally decided to use the counters used heretofore in the office of Treasurer for the present time. The Treasurer was instructed to write Pembroke Company, thanking them for their kindness in preparing plans and submitting same to this office.

It was moved and passed that the matter of lighting the court house be held for another month pending the submitting of bids for such work from local electricians.

The Clerk and Auditor was authorized to publish the Auditor's Financial Statement in the local papers, and to omit the publishing of each warrant drawn as a separate item, but rather as a whole.
