

CITY FATHERS CALL FOR BIDS ON NEW WATER SYSTEM

The call for bids for the construction of an extension on the Cedar City waterworks system, appears on another page of this issue of the Record. The bids will be opened at 11 a. m. on Friday, December 16th., in the city offices.

The extension is to be made as a P. W. A. project, with the federal government providing 45 per cent of the total cost, and work must be started by January 1st., or the government support will be withdrawn.

The contract to be let is for the construction of a pipe line from Shurtz canyon to Cedar City, and the construction of a water storage reservoir. The cost will be approximately \$163,000.00.
