

# New Clinic To Open In Cedar City Soon

Drs. J. W. Bergstrom and Reed W. Farnsworth, announce that within the next week a new Southern Utah Clinic will be opened in Cedar City in the present offices of Drs. Bergstrom and Elmore, with Dr. Bergstrom, Dr. Farnsworth, and Dr. Veri Broadbent of Chicago associated together to form the clinic. Dr. Frank H. Petty, dentist, will also be associated.

The offices are now being completely renovated and remodeled to provide convenient and attractive offices for the three-doctor clinic, and be ready for formal opening within a few days.

Dr. Broadbent who will arrive in Cedar City this month to join with Dr. Bergstrom and Dr. Farnsworth, is a native of Utah having been born in Heber, a son of Sylvester Broadbent, prominent Utah citizen who at this time is President of the Utah Wool Marketing Association. Reed Broadbent, who is in charge of the State Board of Health Laboratory at the Iron County hospital, is a brother of Dr. Broadbent.

Dr. Broadbent, whose training and practice has been devoted principally to surgery, received his training at the University of Utah and at the Rush Medical College in Chicago, and since his graduation has been practicing in Chicago where he has had a very successful practice.

Dr. Lewis F. Elmore, who has been associated with Dr. Bergstrom since the death of Dr. M. J. Macfarlane, has withdrawn from the firm and will leave soon to locate in Los Angeles.
