

Enterprise Man Reported Killed

Sgt. Dwight Hulet Jones of Enterprise, has been unofficially reported as killed in action while serving with the armed forces in Italy.

Sgt. Jones' death was reported to his wife in a letter from his buddie, Robert Acela. The letter, received by Mrs. Jones on June 21st., and written from Acela's home in Des Moines, Iowa, stated that Sgt. Jones was killed on October 17, 1944, while serving with a Tank Corps in the Fifth Army in Italy, and that Acela was with him at the time of death.

Sgt. Jones had served overseas since July, 1942, in England, North Africa and Italy.

Survivors include his wife and son, Lillian Prince Jones and Norman Dwight Jones; his parents, Mr. and Mrs. Arthur P. Jones, of Enterprise; five brothers, Theone Jones, Pingree, Idaho; Marion Jones, Baggs, Wyoming; Herman Jones, Los Angeles; Trenton and Thayne Jones, Enterprise, and three sisters, Agnes Hunt, Veyo; Hop Truman and Carita Staheli, Enterprise.
