

New Book Written By Local Author

"Cedar City—Gateway to Rainbow Land" is the title of a new booklet, which paints a "community portrait" of Cedar and, has just been released by the author, Gustive O. Larson of Cedar City.

The booklet, which deals with the history of Cedar City from the time of Father Escalante to the present day, was printed by the Iron County Record Publishing Co. The cover was done by the Wheelwright Lithographing Co. of Salt Lake City. The cover was prepared by Mrs. Larson, wife of the author.
