

Bright Prospects for St. George.

Mr. Hanchett, head expert for Samuel Newhouse, has been visiting St. George, and after a thorough inspection of the Paymaster mine, has approved the work already done by Supt. Adams and authorized Mr. Adams to expend the further sum of \$75,000 on the property. Workmen have already gone out to erect homes for about twenty additional mine employees.

Mr. Hanchett has also been investigating a site for a railroad, the supposed route to be from Acoma if suitable grade is found, and as stated elsewhere is conferring with the citizens in regard to the erecting of an electric light plant on the Cottonwood water site. If these projected enterprises materialize, as we have reason to hope they will from the moving spirit behind them, St. George will enjoy a boom to put its sister towns in the shade and bring an era of prosperity to the entire Dixie country.
