

Will Erect Monument Where Aviator Died

Major Richard N. McDonald, who conducted the final search that led to the discovery of Maurice Graham's body, returned to Cedar City Thursday from Los Angeles.

The purpose of his present visit is to go back to the spot where his former pal's body was found and erect a small stone monument in memory of Graham's heroic flight.

Also, a parchment relating to the story of the lost flier's death will be buried close by. Sheriff J. T. Leigh accompanied Major McDonald on the trip to Crystal Gulch. They left early yesterday morning. Letters of appreciation have been received from Mrs. Graham by the four local men who took active part in the last search and discovered the body of her husband.
