

Colorado Seeks Zion Easter Pageant Rights

Recognizing the value of the recently discontinued Zion Easter Pageant as a publicity feature and appropriate Easter Sunday service, the Chamber of Commerce of Grand Junction, Colorado has offered to purchase the rights, equipment and costumes. If the deal is made the pageant will be presented in a national monument near Grand Junction.

The presentation of the pageant in Zion National Park has been discontinued as the result of objections raised by the L. D. S. church leaders in Salt Lake City.

Southern Utah's loss will be Colorado's gain because the pageant was fast gaining recognition as the outstanding Easter observance of the West.
