

Iron County Plans Old Folks Home

County Commissioner I. E. Riddle head of the County Welfare Department, announces that the Commissioners are considering a plan to establish a County Old Folks Home, to provide a suitable place to care for the old folks of the county who need such assistance.

At the last meeting of the Board of County Commissioners, a committee composed of Commissioner Riddle, County Attorney Durham Morris, and County Clerk Clair Rowley, was appointed to investigate the matter fully. This committee will study a number of possible buildings that might be purchased for use as a county home.

No definite decision has been made as yet, but a number of homes in Parowan that may be suitable are available, and at least some of them will undoubtedly receive favorable consideration.
