## Burns L. Finlinson To Leave Branch College

The Branch Agricultural College loses another outstanding faculty member, with the announcement of the resignation of Burns L. Finlinson, head of the Social Science Department at the College Dean of men and Veterans Coordinator. Mr. Finlinson will leave to accept a position in the Bakerfield, California, Junior College.

Mr. Finlinson will leave CV ar City soon after the first of month to take up his new duties, after having served at the Branch College here for the past twelve years, during which time he has won much recognition as a teacher and as a civic leader in the community.

He will become Veteran Coordinator in the California school, serving strictly in an administrative capacity.

Mr. Finlinson, besides meeting with success as a teacher has become recognized as a civic leader in Cedar City. At the present time he is a member of the City Council, and is in charge of city public safety activities; is a member of the city Planning Commission, and a member of the Board of Directors of the Lions Club, an organization in which he has been very active in recent years. He has also served as a member of the Boad of Directors of the Cedar City Chamber of Commerce, and has given leadership to a number of that organization's most important activities.

He is president of the Southern Utah Teachers Association, and represented the state Education Association at the convention of the National Education Association at Baltimore this summer.
